AIDS Knowledge

Present the following information in a logbook and share with the Assessor:

- I. What is AIDS.
- II. What is HIV? How does HIV infection affect the human body?
- III. What are the characteristics of HIV (i.e. how does it behave)? How is it transmitted?
- IV. How do you determine if someone is infected by HIV?
- V. How you can prevent contracting HIV for each method of transmission.
- VI. Can AIDS be cured with medication?
- VII. When is World AIDS Day?
- VIII. What is the meaning of the AIDS Red Ribbon?
- IX. Collect at least 5 leaflets or posters about AIDS and explain each of them. (Photocopies or downloaded copies are acceptable).
- X. With images and written descriptions, briefly introduce 2 organisations in Hong Kong involved in AIDS work: one Government department and one non-governmental organisation.
- XI. What would you do if you had a friend infected with HIV?
