Camp Preparation

- I. Sketch a layout of a Patrol campsite and demonstrate how to pitch, strike and air a tent.
- II. Out-of-doors, make a fireplace, light a fire or use a gas stove and cook on it. Explain the storage of food.
- III. Each member of the Patrol must describe and demonstrate how to roll and tie up camp bedding and pack their own rucksacks.
- IV. Make the below gadgets:
 - 1. Sleeping tent
 - 2. Kitchen tent
 - 3. Table
 - 4. Wash tent
 - 5. Improvise a flagpole and hoist the Unit Flag
- V. Have a First Aid kit and show to deal with burns, scalds, cuts and sprains.
- VI. Plan a two-night-three-days camp and make a camp plan book including camp programme, menu and budget.
- VII. During the assessment, carry out an activity which can only be done out-of-doors, e.g. play a wild game or make something out of natural material.
- VIII. Explain to the Assessor the camp safety precautions, including Country Code, use of whistle or fire drill, etc.

Assessor's Qualifications

- 1. An appointed Guider who holds a valid Camper's Licence may take this pennant assessment for her own Unit.
- 2. The Current Division Camp Consultant may take this pennant assessment for Guides from her Division.
