

Ranger Young Leader Qualification

Objectives:

1. To put Guide Motto – “Be prepared” into practice.
2. To enhance and strengthen planning and collaboration capabilities of Rangers.
3. To give back to the community and be responsible Rangers through social services and real-world applications to leadership skills.
4. To provide opportunities to train each Rangers as a young leader.

Eligibility:

1. Ranger aged 18 or above.
2. Completed the Ranger Challenge Badge (Silver).
3. Served as a member of the Executive Committee of the unit for at least one year.

Requirements:

1. Ranger shall complete Level 1 of the Leader Training Course (Brownie / Guides Session). (Ranger who has completed the course can be exempted from this part.)
2. Ranger shall serve as a unit helper for not less than three months in a Brownie / Guides unit after the completion of the Leader Training Course and shall: -
 - Inform the District Commissioner before the commencement of the service as a unit helper;
 - Attend not less than 10 meetings, including one outing / themed meeting;
 - Plan and preside over two of the meetings, and submit a meeting proposal to the Guider of the service unit in advance of the meeting; and
 - Be recommended by the Guider of the service unit.

After completion of the service, a report must be submitted to the Ranger's Unit Guider and conduct a sharing session within her unit. The report shall be assessed and approved by the Unit Guider and its Executive Committee.

Qualification of Assessor:

An appointed Guider may assess this qualification for her own unit.

Ranger who has passed assessment shall:

Be awarded with Ranger Young Leader Qualification Badge to wear on Ranger Shoulder Tab.



Remarks:

- Ranger must complete all the above before her 23rd birthday.
- This Qualification fulfils the second item in Ranger Bauhinia Badge assessment requirement.
- Ranger shall apply service to a Brownie / Guides unit through their Unit Guider or the assistance of the Region Development Department. The service unit shall be in the same guiding session as the Brownie / Guides Session attended in the Leader Training Course.
- Recommendation shall be granted by the District Commissioner for those who attend the Leader Training Course as a Ranger.
