The Hong Kong Girl Guides Association COVID-19 Safety Measures and Guidelines for Face-to-face Meetings

In times of COVID-19 epidemic, ALL face-to-face meetings should obtain approval from respective Deputy Chief Commissioner. These meetings only allow adult members to participate, and should comply with the requirements stipulated under Prevention and Control of Disease (Prohibition of Group Gathering) Regulation (Cap.599G) and strictly adhere to the following guidelines of the Association:

- 1. Adult members should wear surgical masks in all areas while attending approved activities or face-to-face meetings.
- 2. ALL approved activities should designate a person to take temperature screening for all staff and participants. All participants are required to submit the "Declaration form for travel history and health status" to the person-in-charge.
- 3. Anyone under the following circumstances should not attended related activity of face-to-face meeting:
 - (1) fever;
 - (2) feeling unwell;
 - (3) visited Mainland China in past 14 days before the event;
 - (4) had contact with confirmed cases of novel coronavirus infection in past 14 days;
 - (5) undergoing 14-day medical surveillance after returning to Hong Kong; or
 - (6) undergoing 14-day medical surveillance after returning from the countries with quarantine restrictions imposed by the HKSAR Government.
- 4. Reduce social contact such as shake hands or chit chat during the event.
- 5. The above arrangements are effective immediately until further notice.

Note: Rangers (including aged 18 or above) are classified as youth member but NOT adult members.
