## • WHAT is Hong Kong Girl Guides?

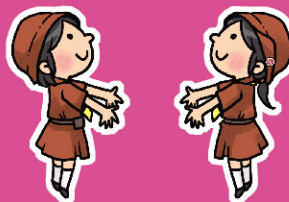
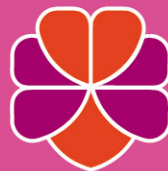
